1. Complete On-Call/Orientation Checklist	<input type="checkbox"/>	
2. Must be licensed for at least two-thirds of the program	<input type="checkbox"/>	
3. Complete all learning experiences <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Eight concentrated learning experiences (six core and two electives) + Orientation b. Longitudinal learning experiences (Pharmacotherapist On-Call, Academia, Practice Management, Staffing, Research Project) 	<input type="checkbox"/>	
4. Completion of all scheduled on call shifts (minimum of 38), ranging between 12 – 24 direct patient care hours per shift	<input type="checkbox"/>	
5. Completion of all scheduled weekend (both Sat and Sun) staffing shifts (minimum of seven weekends) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Eight hour shift: staffing OR b. 12 hour shift: four hour short call followed by eight hour staffing depending on the needs of the department 	<input type="checkbox"/>	
6. Complete a medication use evaluation (MUE) and present to hospital committee or at a professional meeting	<input type="checkbox"/>	
7. Complete and present at a professional meeting: a case report/ series, MUE, or retrospective QI project	<input type="checkbox"/>	
8. Complete one longitudinal research project <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Obtain IRB approval b. Conduct research c. Present results at a meeting (NYSCHP, NYCRC, etc) d. Submit acceptable manuscript (reviewed by preceptor) 	<input type="checkbox"/>	
9. Present a minimum of eight pharmacotherapy grand rounds presentations (patient case, topic/ CE, clinical pearls, platform presentation, etc)	<input type="checkbox"/>
