- Orientation**

- Patient Care** Three core rotations (divided throughout the year)
1. Family Medicine*
 - Focused in Pharmacotherapy Clinics
 - Anticoagulation, Annual Wellness Visits
 2. Internal Medicine*
 - Focused in Anticoagulation Clinics
 - Pharmacotherapy clinics
 3. HIV Primary Care*
 - Focused in Interdisciplinary Clinics
 - Anticoagulation and Pharmacotherapy Clinics
- Electives
1. Concentrated Transitions of Care
 2. Concentrated Hematology/Oncology
 3. Longitudinal Pulmonology
 4. Longitudinal Rheumatology
 5. Longitudinal Hematology/Oncology

- Give lectures at Pharmacy Grand Rounds
 - Teach small group academic sessions
 - Co-precept APPE students
 - Serve as primary preceptor to APPE students (*optional*)

- One longitudinal project (usually prospective)
