- Patient Care** Three core rotations (divided throughout the year)
1. Family Medicine\*
    - Focused in Pharmacotherapy Clinics
    - Anticoagulation, Annual Wellness Visits
  2. Internal Medicine\*
    - Focused in Anticoagulation Clinics
    - Pharmacotherapy clinics
  3. HIV Primary Care\*
    - Focused in Interdisciplinary Clinics
    - Anticoagulation and Pharmacotherapy Clinics

- Academia**

- Research**
- One longitudinal project (usually prospective)
  - Additional smaller project (ie. Case series, retrospective)

- Orientation period

  - Complete pharmacokinetic monitoring, answer drug information questions, manage nutrition consults
