Antimicrobial Stewardship Program I	5 weeks
Academia and Precepting (if completing teaching certificate)	Longitudinal 39 weeks; 2 hour seminar once a month and varied weekly commitments for one semester depending on assigned recitation
Infectious Diseases Consult Service I	6 weeks
Orientation	2 weeks
HIV Outpatient (concentrated)	3 weeks
HIV Clinic	Longitudinal 52 weeks; weekly
Infectious Diseases Specialist	6 weeks
Foundations of Microbiology	2 weeks
Infection Prevention and Control	2 weeks
Infectious Diseases in Immunocompromised Patients	4 weeks
Research	Longitudinal 50 weeks; up to 10 dedicated project days (five in the Fall and five in the Spring)
Pharmacotherapist On-call	Longitudinal 52 weeks; 12 to 24 hour shifts approximately once every 2 weeks
Pharmacy Practice Management	Longitudinal 52 weeks; evenly spaced self and preceptor evaluations
